Dear Residents:

It is time to propose the school budget to our community. Your Board continued to work hard at keeping the school budget costs reasonable and at the same time making sure the children receive a program that meets our community's expectations. It is a delicate balance between ensuring that costs are contained and approving expenses that allow the school district to maintain its outstanding reputation by providing the students educational quality. Since 2013 the average tax levy increase has been 2.47% and an average tax rate of 2.30%. This year the anticipated tax levy is 2.56% and a tax rate of 2.26%. As reported in Newsday, the Suffolk County average tax levy is 2.78%. The Board is pleased to present to the community an anticipated school tax levy amount below the County average while providing excellent programs for the September 2018 school year. The proposed budget is also below the County averages for two years in a row. This proposed budget only grew 2.24% over the current year's budget.

The East Moriches program is rich with academic opportunities that challenge our students and provide a solid foundation to prepare them for high school. The Board also recognizes that our staff and faculty members work very hard to provide daily lessons that far exceed that of other schools in a safe and well-maintained environment. If approved, the budget provides improved fiscal stability reflected by the positive rating given by the New York State Comptroller's Office Fiscal Monitoring System. The Board is very pleased that the District's fiscal health continues to remain strong.

We wish all of our student's success on the fields and in the classrooms as we plan for the upcoming school year. We hope to see you at a Board meeting or any one of the many programs and events scheduled for this spring. In closing, we would like to say thank you for your past support, and we urge you to vote on May 15th from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the elementary school.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS

To vote in school district elections you must be:

- a citizen of the United States
- a resident of the district for at least 30 days
- at least 18 years of age
- registered to vote in *either* the general or the school election

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Written applications for absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk seven days before the election on May 15, 2018. If an absentee voter intends to pick up the ballot in person, that application must be received at least one day before the election. All completed absentee ballots must be filed with the district clerk by 5:00 p.m. on the day of the vote.

Did You Know?

Tax Relief

Senior Citizens (65 or older) whose annual income is under \$36,399 may receive tax relief of between 5% and 50%. BOE Policy 4601

Physically Disabled residents who make improvements to property to facilitate the use and accessibility of their residence may have such improvements exempt from taxation. BOE Policy 4603

Volunteer Companies (Firefighters’ and Ambulance Workers’): Resident members of at least 5 years may be eligible for a reduction in property taxes equal to 10% of assessed valuation. BOE Policy 4602

“STAR”: *All resident* property owners are eligible for tax relief under the New York State STAR program. If you have already applied, you need not do so again. Senior citizens whose adjusted gross income is under \$86,000 (in 2017) and under \$86,000 (in 2018) are entitled to an enhanced STAR reduction and must re-apply each year.

PROPOSITION I: To adopt the annual budget of said School District for the fiscal year 2018-2019 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation of the taxable property of the District at a tax levy increase of 2.56%

PROPOSITON II: To designate high schools of the following school districts as receiving high schools for the residents of East Moriches Union Free School District for up to five (5) years beginning July 1, 2018 and ending on June 30, 2023 for the grades set forth after each high school: Center Moriches, grades 9-12; Eastport South-Manor, grades 9-12; Westhampton Beach, grades 9-12.

PROPOSITION III: That the Board of Education of the East Moriches Union Free School District be authorized to contract with the Suffolk Cooperative Library System for a period of one year only, commencing July 1, 2018 for direct access library services, for a sum not to exceed \$794,592.85, in addition to the sum set forth in Proposition I, and to raise the requisite portion thereof by taxation on the taxable property of the district.
